Ten-Year Arrest Trends, Totals, 2009–2018

- Nationwide, the number of persons arrested in 2018 decreased 21.9 percent when compared with the number of those arrested in 2009.
- In 2018, the number of arrests for violent crimes decreased 11.0 percent when compared with 2009 arrest figures. Of the violent crimes, in a comparison of 2018 and 2009 arrest data, the number of arrests for robbery had the largest drop at 30.9 percent.
- The number of arrests for property crimes decreased 31.2 percent when compared with 2009 arrest figures. Of the property crimes, the number of arrests for burglary decreased the most (40.9 percent) in a comparison of 2018 and 2009 arrest data.
- The number of adults arrested in 2018 decreased 16.2 percent when compared with the number of adults arrested in 2009.
- When compared with 2009 arrest data, the number of juveniles (individuals under age 18) arrested in 2018 dropped 58.5 percent.
