Ten-Year Arrest Trends, Totals, 2010–2019

- Nationwide, the number of persons arrested in 2019 decreased 21.0 percent when compared with the number of those arrested in 2010.
- In 2019, the number of arrests for violent crimes decreased 7.8 percent when compared with 2010 arrest figures. Of the violent crimes, in a comparison of 2019 and 2010 arrest data, the number of arrests for robbery had the largest drop at 25.4 percent.
- The number of arrests for property crimes decreased 29.6 percent when compared with 2010 arrest figures. Of the property crimes, the number of arrests for burglary decreased the most (40.8 percent) in a comparison of 2019 and 2010 arrest data.
- The number of adults arrested in 2019 decreased 16.0 percent when compared with the number of adults arrested in 2010.
- When compared with 2010 arrest data, the number of juveniles (individuals under age 18) arrested in 2019 dropped 55.5 percent.
