



Hate Crime Statistics

Each year, the FBI publishes data concerning bias-motivated offenses reported by law enforcement to gauge the scope and nature of hate crime in the nation. This report chronicles crimes that were motivated by bias against race, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity/national origin, or disability. Tables in the report include information about the types of offenses committed, some traits of the victims and the offenders, and aggregate hate crime offense counts by state and agency type.

Data availability

The 2011 edition of the annual report *Hate Crime Statistics* is tentatively scheduled for release in December 2012.

Available formats

When the data become available, data users will be able to access the information in Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) files, Adobe Acrobat files, or Microsoft Excel spreadsheets. A press release, which will be issued concurrently with *Hate Crime Statistics, 2011*, will be available in HTML and Adobe Acrobat.
