



## **U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI)**

Within the DOI in 2016, 621 officers were attacked. Of these officers, 1 officer was injured with a firearm, and 116 sustained injuries from weapons other than firearms. (See Tables 123 and 124.) The following provides information by agency within the DOI:

- Bureau of Indian Affairs—504 officers were attacked, 1 of whom was injured with a firearm and 85 of whom were injured with weapons other than firearms. (See Tables 123 and 124.)
- Bureau of Land Management—4 officers were assaulted, none were injured. (See Tables 123 and 124.)
- National Park Service—107 officers were assaulted, 31 of whom sustained injuries from weapons other than firearms. (See Tables 123 and 124.)
- U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service—6 officers were assaulted; none were injured. (See Tables 123 and 124.)

### ***Type of activity (See Table 130.)***

At the time of the attacks, officers from the DOI were performing the following activities:

- 235 officers were on patrol or guard duty.
- 181 officers were making arrests or serving summonses.
- 128 officers were conducting investigations or searches.
- 35 officers were maintaining custody of prisoners.
- 23 officers were assigned to office duty.
- 19 officers were performing other official duties.

### ***Weapons (See Table 127.)***

Weapons used against the DOI officers during the attacks include the following:

- 241 officers were assaulted with personal weapons, such as hands, fists, or feet.
- 24 officers were assaulted with firearms.
- 19 officers were assaulted with vehicles.
- 13 officers were assaulted with knives or other cutting instruments.
- 10 officers were assaulted with blunt instruments.
- 314 officers were assaulted with other types of weapons.

### ***Dispositional information (See Tables 123 and 131.)***

Law enforcement authorities identified 520 suspects in the assaults on DOI officers. At the time of this report, the following dispositional information was available for 313 of the 520 suspects:

- 242 suspects were found guilty.
- 45 suspects were awaiting trial.
- 11 suspects' cases were pending prosecutive opinion.
- 9 suspects' prosecutions were declined.
- 2 suspects were fugitives.
- 2 suspects are deceased.
- 1 suspect was found not guilty or the charges were dismissed.
- 1 suspect was determined to be incompetent to stand trial.
