



U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) Police

In 2017, 23 U.S. DoD police officers were assaulted. Of the officers assaulted, 2 sustained injuries. All of the assaulted officers worked with the Department of the Navy. (See Tables [71](#) and [73](#).)

Type of activity (See Table [78](#).)

All of the 23 officers assaulted were conducting investigations or searches.

Weapons (See Table [75](#).)

The DOD reported the 23 officers were assaulted with other types of weapons that were not firearms, knives or other cutting instruments, bombs, blunt instruments, personal weapons (such as hands, feet, or fists), or vehicles.

Law enforcement authorities identified 11 suspects in the assaults on DoD officers; all 11 suspects were found guilty.
