



Data Declaration

Crimes Against Persons, Property, or Society Offenses Offense Category by Location, 2011

The FBI collects these data through the FBI UCR Program's NIBRS.

General Comment

These tables show the number of offenses per offense category by the location where the offense(s) occurred. The offense categories were then divided into tables for Crimes Against Persons, Crimes Against Property, and Crimes Against Society.

Methodology

This table uses the following rules and then aggregates the data by location of the incident:

- Offenses columns – count as follows for each offense type in Data Element 6 (UCR Offense Code) and then combine the figures into offense categories:
 - Crime Against Person: count one for each victim, i.e., Victim Segment.
 - Crime Against Property: count one for each unique offense type.
 - Crime Against Society: count one for each unique offense type.
- In a multiple-offense incident, count one for each offense type in the incident.
