



## NIBRS Participation by Population Group

By 2012, 6,115 law enforcement agencies (approximately 33 percent of all UCR agencies) reported crime to the FBI UCR Program using NIBRS data specifications. These agencies cover approximately 29 percent of the population in the United States.
