## NIBRS Participation by State

Based on 2012 data submissions, the FBI UCR Program has certified 32 states to report data via the NIBRS. Of the 32 certified states, 15 states (Arkansas, Delaware, Idaho, lowa, Michigan, Montana, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Vermont, Virginia, and West Virginia) submit all their crime data via the NIBRS. Of the agencies within these states, more than 41 percent reported all of their statistics via the NIBRS. This represented 30 percent of the U.S. population covered by UCR participants and accounted for 28 percent of all crime reported to the FBI UCR Program.
