<sup>1</sup>This table does not include totals because in the table a victim can be counted more than once since he/she can be connected to up to ten offense types per incident, up to five types of injury, and up to three weapons per offense type.

<sup>2</sup>Type Weapon/Force Involved is collected for 13 NIBRS offense types and Type of Injury is collected for 9 offense types. This table only includes information for the Forcible Sex Offense types. Although Murder and Nonnegligent Manslaughter is not typically included as a type of injury, it is included in this table for informational purposes as it relates to the type of weapon/force used to commit the offense against the victim.
