

## **Data Declaration**

## Sex Offenses Incidents, Offenses, Victims, and Known Offenders by Offense Type, 2013

The FBI collects these data through the FBI UCR Program's NIBRS.

## **General Comment**

This table shows the number of incidents, offenses, victims, and known offenders by offense type.

## Methodology

This table counts offense types, victims, or offenders using the following rules:

- Incidents count one for each sex offense type identified in Data Element 6 (UCR Offense Code) within each NIBRS incident.
- Offenses count one for each victim, i.e., Victim Segment, connected to each sex offense type in the incident (in a multiple-offense incident, count a victim for each connected sex offense type).
- Victims count one for each victim, i.e., Victim Segment, connected to each sex offense type in the incident (in a multiple-offense incident, a victim is counted for *each* connected sex offense type).
- Known Offenders count one for each offender, i.e., Offender Segment, connected to each sex offense type in the incident (do not count Offender Segments with an Unknown Offender).
