



## Data Declaration

### Victims

### Age Category by Offense Category, 2013

The FBI collects these data through the FBI UCR Program's NIBRS.

### General Comment

This table shows the age category of the victim by the offense category to which they were connected.

### Methodology

This table uses the following rules and then aggregates the data by the age category of the victims and offense category:

- Victims – count one for each victim, i.e., Victim Segment, where Data Element 25 (Type of Victim) is I = Individual or L = Law Enforcement Officer for each offense type to which they were connected via Data Element 24 (Victim Connected to UCR Offense Code); in a multiple-offense incident, count a victim for each connected offense type.
- Age Category – for this table, an Adult is a victim who is age 18 or older and a Juvenile is a victim who is under 18 years of age. The Unknown column represents the number of victims where the victim's age was unknown.
