



## NIBRS Participation by State

Based on 2013 data submissions, the FBI UCR Program has certified 33 states to report data via the NIBRS. Of the 33 certified states, 15 states (Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Idaho, Iowa, Michigan, Montana, New Hampshire, North Dakota, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Vermont, Virginia, and West Virginia) submit all their crime data via the NIBRS. Additionally, the program has certified agencies in 4 states to directly report data to the NIBRS.
