CAUTION

Ahmad Fathi is wanted for his alleged involvement in a conspiracy to conduct a coordinated campaign of distributed denial of service ("DDoS") attacks against the United States financial sector and other United States companies from 2011 through 2013. Fathi is the director and owner of ITSecTeam, also known as Amnpardazesh Kharazmi, an Iranian information technology company. He allegedly supervised and coordinated ITSecTeam's involvement in the DDoS campaign, and was involved in, among other things, building the botnet used to conduct the campaign, as well as ITSecTeam's development of malicious software used to execute the attacks.

On January 21, 2016, a grand jury in the United States District Court, Southern District of New York, indicted Fathi for his involvement in the scheme and a federal warrant was issued for his arrest after he was charged with conspiracy to commit, and aid and abet, computer intrusion.
